START OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Punctuality matters!

KS2 pupils should be on the playground at 8.45am and line up when the bell is rung.

KS1 pupils should be on the playground at 8.50am

Pupils who are late after the close of register, which is 9.10am for ALL pupils, will be marked with a 'U' code—this counts as an absence mark and reflects upon your child's overall attendance. Together with unauthorised absences this *can* result in a fine for parents over time.

REMEMBER :

On the KS2 playground the bell is rung at 8.45am and doors to classroom areas are closed at 8.50am.

In KS1 the teachers collect the children at 8.50am and the outer doors close 5 minutes later.

After this point children are late and must use the main entrance to be safely registered.
