Overall school attendance is 96.22%

Good attendance in Sherdley is above 96%.

Overall attendance at Sherdley is good compared to the averages for St Helens and England. However, the attendance of some children is still a concern.

We expect children to be ill; especially children lower down the school; as they pick up germs and develop immunity for the future. When children are ill we need them to stay at home and get well. If you visit a chemist, doctors or the 'Walk in' always ask for a card or slip which you can pass into school. We can then update the registers and our records.

When looking at registers the patterns which we most closely monitor are 'odd days off' with no, or repeated reasons, such as 'poorly', or 'sick'. Several of these will result in a 'Medical Evidence' required letter being sent home meaning that we will monitor future attendance even more closely.



Remember to be on time for school

Junior pupils need to be in the line for 8:45; learning will have started by 8.50am!

Reception and infant pupils should be in the line for 8:50 to ensure a prompt start to learning.
