We are currently experiencing the drop-in attendance which always hits at this time of year due to nasty coughs and colds.

We have also noticed a drop off in punctuality for some pupils. Please remember that KS2 children should be on the playground at 8.45am to be on time; class doors close at 8.50am after which pupils are LATE. In KS1 and Reception children need to be on the playground at 8.50am with doors closing at 8.55am.

Punctuality is a life lesson for children and we would encourage you to ensure children arrive in school on time, every day.
