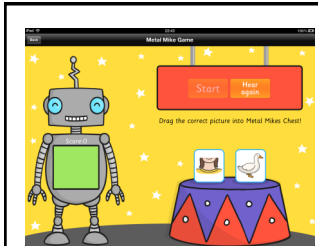
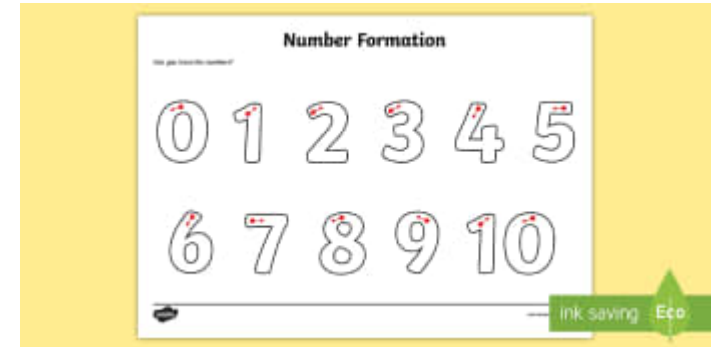
'Growing Together, Respecting Each Other'
