Please could you ensure that all the appropriate forms are completed by next week.

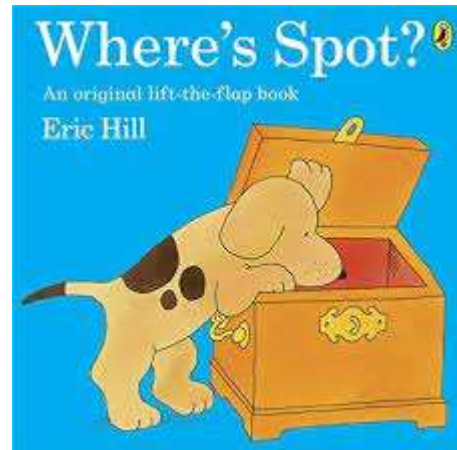
Thank you very much if you have already filled in the forms.
