## Different Bears

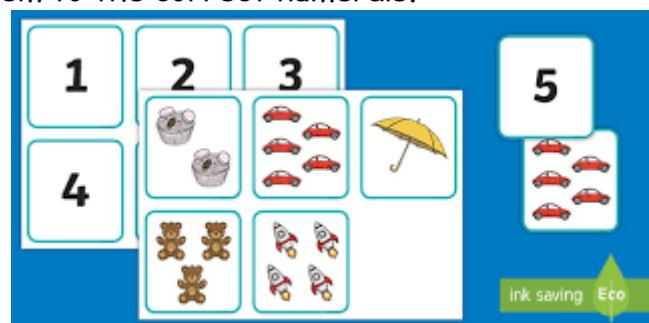
This week we have been looking at different types of bears and where they live.
