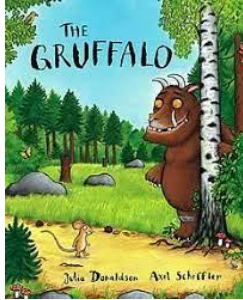

The children have been looking at different maps and talking about what they can see on a map.
