Completing this activity with your child helps them reach these age related expectations:

Mathematics:

To make comparisons between objects relating to size - height.

To use the language tall and short related to height.



This week in mathematics we have looking at the different heights of Jasper's beanstalks as it grew. We then had to sort the various heights and put them in order starting with the shortest one. Finally, we ended up with the tallest beanstalk.

For this homework could you look at the different heights of the people in your family that live with you. Can you draw them in height order and talk about who is the tallest and who is the shortest?
